Project Description:

As one of the contractors for Professional and Technical Services selected by Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality, Environmental Management Services, provided investigative services in an effort to determine the environmental condition of the former Struthers Industries property in Gulfport, Mississippi, for potential redevelopment. The initial investigation (Phase I Environmental Site Assessment) included historic research into the property to determine potential environmental concerns along with site reconnaissance to determine current site conditions. The review concluded with several areas identified as potential environmental concerns. Further investigation was conducted with sampling and analytical analysis of different media which determined impact to the environment from the historical industrial use. The information obtained from the investigations was used to develop budgetary costs associated with the remediation of the property for redevelopment.



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
